M29 PROJECT – NOTICE OF PROJECT COMMENCEMENT

On August 23, 2007, the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission") issued to Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison") a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (the "Certificate"), under Article VII of the New York Public Service Law, authorizing the construction and operation of the M29 Transmission Line Project (the "Project"). Work on the transmission line portion of the Project will not begin until Con Edison receives Commission approval of the Environmental Management and Construction Plan for that portion of the Project.

The Project consists of a single 345 kV high-pressure, fluid-filled, primarily underground transmission facility to be constructed along an approximately 9.5 mile route from Con Edison's existing Sprain Brook Substation in the City of Yonkers to Con Edison's new Academy Substation to be constructed at the site of Con Edison's former Sherman Creek Generating Station, between West 201st Street and Academy Street in the Inwood section of upper Manhattan. Construction of the Academy Substation and M29-related construction work at the existing Sprain Brook Substation are part of the Project. Work at the Sprain Brook Substation, located northwest of the intersection of Tuckahoe Road and the Sprain Brook Parkway in Yonkers, will include the installation of electric and related equipment within the confines of the substation. The feeder route, including the locations of the Sprain Brook and Academy Substations, is highlighted on the map included with this notice in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Certificate. Con Edison anticipates that it will begin construction on the substation portions of the Project on or about September 27, 2007.
