**16. Reconnection of Service - Continued**

- (D) Where the Company fails to reconnect service to a residential Customer within 24 hours or neglects to do so without good cause the Company shall pay a penalty of up to \$50.00 per day to the Customer in accordance with the Public Service Commission's regulations.

**17. Parts Replacement Program**

**(A) Applicability:**

To Customers receiving service under Service Classification Nos. 1 or 3 of this Rate Schedule.

**(B) Coverage:**

The program covers gas space heating equipment up to 400,000 BTU/hr. and/or gas water heating equipment with inputs not greater than 95,000 BTU/hr. as determined from the nameplate rating of the equipment or from the design specifications of the manufacturer of the equipment. All equipment to be repaired by the Company must be approved by the authorities having jurisdiction over the manufacture and the installation of such equipment. In the case of a parts replacement contract, the equipment must be in good operating condition on the date the contract takes effect. The program will not cover any labor or materials for draining boiler water, draining expansion tanks, venting radiators, nor any type of repair considered plumbing, sheet metal work, or work on electrical house wiring. Work restricted to licensed plumbers will not be performed.

The program will also not include the replacement of a defective space heating or water heating unit and a service contract does not include an annual or any routine inspection of the Customer's equipment.

**(B) Coverage - Continued**

Service will not be provided under the contract if the Company determines on the initial service call that either the equipment is not serviceable or there are unsafe working conditions. The Customer may cancel the contract under either circumstance on written notice to the Company, and the Company will refund the full amount paid by the Customer for the current contract.

**(C) Plans and Charges:**

Two types of plans are available to Customers. There is no charge for responding to the Customer's premises under either plan.

**(1) Plan A - Parts Replacement Contracts:**

For the annual charges set forth below, a parts replacement contract will cover parts and labor to install the parts for one year.

One space heating unit, including a single basic thermostat, and one water heating unit \$ 85.00

One space heating unit, including a single basic thermostat \$ 75.00

One water heating unit \$ 48.00

For each additional heating zone with thermostat, the cost is an additional \$10.00 per zone.

If there is more than one gas-fired space heater or water heater on the premises, a separate parts replacement contract is required for each space heating and/or water heating unit.

(1) Plan A - Parts Replacement Contracts - Continued

Under this plan, there will be a charge to replace a thermostat having a defective clock mechanism. The thermostat will be replaced by a standard thermostat at a charge equal to the "trade price" (local market price) for the replacement part, increased by a 12 percent storage and handling charge.

(2) Plan B - Parts Replacement at Unit Charges:

Plan B availability on or after October 1, 1998 is limited to Customers whose parts replacement contract under Plan A expired during September or October 1998 and who request service under Plan B within sixty days of the contract's expiration. No service will be available under Plan B on or after December 31, 1998.

Upon the Customer's request, at a unit charge the Company will make the repairs covered under the program to equipment not covered by a parts replacement contract. The unit charge to replace a part shall be the sum of:

(a) the labor charge to install the part as set forth below; and

(b) the price of the part.

Parts whose average storeroom cost is \$20 or less shall be priced at the average storeroom price plus \$10. Parts whose average storeroom cost is more than \$20 shall be priced at the "trade price" (local market price) for the part. All prices for parts shall be increased by a 12 percent storage and handling charge.

(3) Increase in Rates and Charges:

The contract and unit charges will be increased by the effective percentage increase set forth on the "Statement of Percentage Increase in Rates and Charges Applicable to the Gas PLUS Plan" (Statement) filed with the Public Service Commission apart from this Rate Schedule. The effective percentage increase reflects the aggregate percentage rate of taxes imposed on the Company's revenues within the municipality where service is supplied as of the date stated on the Statement and explained in General Information Section VIII "Increase in Rates Applicable in Municipality Where Service is Supplied". The unit charges and the contract charges will be subject to adjustment if the effective percentage increase determined in accordance with General Information Section VIII, excluding the one-time adjustments applicable to the effective percentage increase to reconcile the tax surcharge expenses imposed pursuant to State Tax Law Sections 186, 186-a, and 188, changes by one percent or more from the effective percentage increase shown on the Statement filed with the Public Service Commission.

(4) Statement of Percentage Increase in Rates and Charges Applicable to the Gas PLUS Plan:

The "Statement of Percentage Increase in Rates and Charges Applicable to the Gas PLUS Plan" (Statement) sets forth the applicable effective percentage increase in effect for the various municipalities served by the Company. The Company will file with the Public Service Commission, apart from this Rate Schedule, a revised Statement not less than fifteen business days before the date on which the Company proposes to change the effective percentage increase applicable to this program. A copy of the Statement in effect will be available to the public at the Company's service centers at which application for service can be made.

**(D) Applications for Parts Replacement Contracts:**

Application for a parts replacement contract shall be made in writing on the form set forth in this Rate Schedule. Coverage will commence 10 days from receipt of the Customer's payment and will continue for one year. No contract will be issued with an effective date on or after October 1, 1998. Contracts that expire on or after October 1, 1998 will not be renewed. Contracts that expire on or before September 30, 1998 will be renewed for another one-year term, provided payment is received within 14 days of the last day of the preceding term.

**(E) Billing and Payment of Charges:**

Payment for a parts replacement contract must be made at the time of application. The Customer may cancel the contract within 20 days of the Company's receipt of the Customer's payment if no claim has been made under the contract. The Company will refund the Customer's payment within 30 days of the Customer's request or pay a penalty of 10 percent per month for any amount not refunded within 30 days.

Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of a contract may result in the termination of the contract. In that event, the Customer will not be entitled to a refund for any portion of the amount paid for the current contract.

**(F) Other Terms and Conditions:**

The Company's response time to any service call will be affected by weather conditions and workload. Interchangeable parts will be used when exact replacement parts are not available. Guaranteed rebuilt parts will be used when manufacturer cannot supply new replacement parts.

The Company will not install a replacement part if either:

- (1) a specific part or an acceptable interchangeable alternate part is no longer available to the Company; or
- (2) the removal of the defective part or the installation of a replacement part could cause damage to the unit or an unsafe condition.

The plan does not cover any material, parts or labor required as a result of unusual circumstances, including floods, fire, freezing, natural disaster, civil disobedience, riot, war, or equipment abuse. Customers are responsible for ordinary maintenance of equipment including the replacement of air filters, adjustment of air registers, and lubrication of motors.

If a Customer with a parts replacement contract in effect moves, the contract shall continue to apply to a successor customer at the location without further charge during the remainder of the contract term, but the successor customer will have no right to a refund on either party's cancellation of the contract for any reason.

**(G) Termination of Parts Replacement Contracts:**

The Company reserves the right to cancel all parts replacement contracts if any governmental authority imposes new or additional regulatory requirements that restrict Con Edison's performing contract services for the Customer. The Company will mail a written notice to all Customers at least 15 days prior to canceling the contract. Unless service has been provided during the contract term, the Company will refund to the Customer the prorated annual amount for any full months remaining on the canceled contract.

**IV. Special Services Performed by the Company for Customers at a Charge**

**1. Special Services at Cost**

Upon the Customer's request, the Company will perform the following special services for a Customer and will charge the Customer upon the basis of cost to the Company as defined in Paragraph 2 "Definition of Cost":

- (A)** Change the point of service termination or location of the service pipe as set forth in General Rule III 4 (C);
- (B)** Relocate Company street facilities to accommodate Customers;
- (C)** Remove and relocate Company facilities when a street is to become private property;
- (D)** Make gas main extensions in private roads or streets of real estate developments under a refunding agreement based on use of service, provided that the Customer furnishes evidence of intent, satisfactory to the Company, that the Customer will cede or otherwise transfer said roads or streets for public street purposes to the municipal or other governmental authority having jurisdiction, subject to General Rule III 3 "Installation of Mains and Services";
