To All Customers Receiving Gas Under Pressure

The New York State Public Service Commission (PSC), under authority of the Public Service Law, has directed Con Edison to tell you annually that:

- You are served with elevated gas pressure. This means your gas pressure, at the outlet side of your meter, is greater than one-half pound per square inch (0.5psig).
- You should obtain the services of a qualified individual to perform a safety inspection, which includes your pressure regulators, on an annual basis. Con Edison performed an initial inspection of your installation in the past.
- Your piping system, including pressure-reducing equipment, must meet National Fuel Gas Code NFPPA54/ANSI Z223.1 requirements.
- You should have your licensed plumber file his/her "Plumber's Contractor Work Request" with Con Edison's Energy Services Department before making any additions or modifications to your piping or gas equipment (appliances).
