In accordance with Ordering Paragraphs 20 and 32 of the M29 Transmission Line Project (the "Project") Article VII Certificate ("Certificate") and Section 14.7 of the approved Environmental Management & Construction Plan ("EM&CP") for the substation and transmission line portions of the Project, this report summarizes the Project's construction activities and environmental and related compliance efforts beginning January 1 through January 31, 2008. Through the end of January, Project work continues to be confined to the Academy Substation site.

**Academy Substation Site:**

## PROJECT ACTIVITIES COMPLETED OR ONGOING THIS REPORTING PERIOD

- Con Edison's M29 Project website (<http://www.coned.com/publicissues/M29.asp>) continues to be updated.
- On January 28, 2008, a mailing was sent to residents in communities along the construction route explaining the need and the anticipated timeline for construction of the M29 Project. In response to the mailing, Con Edison received 24 telephone calls and two e-mail requests for further Project information. Con Edison also received 51 requests for placement on the Project mailing list. In one phone call, an individual raised concerns about the route and maintaining access to Conservative Synagogue Adath Israel on 250<sup>th</sup> Street in Riverdale. Con Edison contacted the caller and addressed these concerns, explaining its current plans for maintaining synagogue access and minimizing disruption. The caller was provided additional contact information for Con Edison's Project public affairs liaison.

### **Academy Substation Site:**

- Continued maintenance of the tracking pads, silt fencing, and hay bales around the perimeter of the Academy Substation work area has been ongoing.
- Transport of construction and demolition ("C&D") debris from the site, including obsolete underground facilities, has continued.

### **Sprain Brook Substation:**

- Activity at this location has not yet begun.

**Transmission Feeder Route:**

- ♦ Test pitting along the approved transmission line route in the City of Yonkers has continued.

- ♦ Continue transport of C&D debris from the site.
