







RFP Submittal Reminders

RFP Schedule and Key Dates



Dates are subject to change by the Company

Respondents are encouraged to submit responses before the due date. Con Edison will have no obligation to evaluate late submissions.

- Submit all proposals to nwsproposals@coned.com before March 21, 2025, at 5:00pm.
- Response should include proposal body, applicable NWS Financial Sheet, and appendix attachments as necessary as a Word or PDF document
 1. Proposal with format and content as described below
(Titled: “ProjectName_VendorName_Proposal”)
 2. Proposal attachments (Titled: “ProjectName_VendorName_Attachments”)
 3. NWS Financial Sheet (Attachment A) (Titled: “ProjectName_VendorName_Financials”)
- **Note:** No financial information is to be included in proposal body

Financial information reminders

- No financial information is to be included in proposal body.
- Project cost details, bid information, and requested Con Edison incentive contribution, which should be provided in Financial Sheet Attachment A
- Include details on all expected revenue from system operation. Optimize eligible revenue streams, tax credits, financial incentives, and other funding sources (City, State, Federal) to mitigate costs for Con Edison customers.
- Respondent company's financial statements for the last three years, provided as an attachment
- Attached financial statements and Financial Sheet Attachment A will be kept confidential and limited to the NWS strategy team and Procurement to protect sensitive pricing information

Non-wires solutions have the potential to reduce customers' electric bills, improve reliability, and defer capital infrastructure. We've identified several opportunities to create such change.

Does ConEd have a specific source for load shapes for measures to utilize in the financial template?

- Con Edison will provide 24-hour load shape data for residential and multifamily spaces after the RFP is completed and the contract is awarded.
- For the financial template, and demand savings estimates in your proposal, applicants should provide system peak kW savings values as calculated in the NYS TRM v11. Our intention is to allow respondents to rely on the NYS TRM to reduce the complexity of preparing your proposals.
- If you think that the TRM methodology is insufficient for your specific proposal, applicants may choose to apply load shapes from other industry sources, or adjustments, but should provide their best estimate and any supporting methodology or sources behind their calculations.

Will measures such as time-based controls for water heaters and space conditioning loads be eligible for this program?

- Yes, proposals can include controls capable of delivering load reduction at the network peak hour (8-9pm).
- Applicants should provide supporting evidence around the reliability of demand reduction achieved by the proposed controls measures — such as whether users are able to override settings.


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
