

## **Temporary Restraining Order regarding Low Income Moratorium**

Be advised that in accordance with the Temporary Restraining Order granted on September 28, 2016, the Moratorium prohibiting Con Edison low income program participants to be served by ESCOs has been lifted as of September 30, 2016 for the Con Edison territory. All blocks that had been instituted pursuant to the Moratorium have been removed.

If you de-enrolled any customers in accordance with the Moratorium prior to the issuance of the Temporary Restraining Order, you may re-enroll these customers through EDI under the regular enrollment rules under the UBP.

Your list of ineligible customers on the RAIS and TCIS websites will no longer indicate which customers are ineligible. Please destroy any lists you have on record identifying ineligible customers.
