

PSC Order Regarding the Provision of Service to Low-Income Customers by Energy Service Companies

As per the Public Service Commission's (PSC) December 16, 2016 Order Adopting a Prohibition on Service to Low-Income Customers by Energy Service Companies, we have placed blocks on customers who are no longer eligible to be enrolled with ESCOs, effective July 26, 2017. Please refer to your RAIS (www.coned.com/retailaccess) or TCIS (www.coned.com/TCIS) sync list to determine which accounts are no longer eligible to be served by you.

If your company filed a petition for a waiver of the PSC's prohibition, then this information is not pertinent to you.
