

Fossil Fuels: non-renewable energy sources like coal, gas, and oil that we can't replace once they're used up.




What is Zero Emissions Day?

Purpose: Celebrated on September 21, Zero Emissions Day aims to give the Earth a day free from fossil fuel emissions.

Background: The concept was initiated by Ken Wallace in Nova Scotia, Canada, in the 1980s and officially launched as "ZeDay" in 2008 to promote responsible energy use globally.






Emissions can harm the Earth by polluting the air, making it harder to breathe, and causing the planet to get warmer, leading to problems like melting ice and extreme weather.


Safe and Smart Electricity Use

Use electricity wisely and reduce usage, especially from non-renewable sources, to stay safe and protect the environment.


Unplug to Save Energy


