RE: ELEVATED GAS PRESSURE CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

Dear Customer:

The New York State Public Service Commission (PSC), under authority of the Public Service Law, has directed Con Edison to inform you annually that:

- You are served with elevated gas pressure. This means your gas pressure, at the outlet side of your meter, is greater than one-half pound per square inch (0.5psig).
- You should obtain the services of a qualified individual, such as a licensed plumber, to perform an annual safety inspection that includes your gas pressure regulators. Con Edison performed an initial inspection when your meter was installed.
- Please know that your piping system, including pressure-reducing equipment, must meet the National Fuel Gas Code NFPA54/ANSI Z223.1 requirements. You or your plumber can visit their site (<http://www.nfpa.org/>) for more information.
- If any work is necessary, your licensed plumber must file a "Plumber's Contractor Work Request" with Con Edison's Energy Services Department (<http://www.coned.com/es/>) before making any additions or modifications to your piping or gas equipment, or appliances.

If you have any questions or are planning any changes, please call your licensed plumber or Con Edison at (http://www.coned.com/es/contact_us.asp).

In the interest of safe practices, please review the following important safety information with all of your employees: Be aware that any gas leak poses a dangerous situation. In the event of a gas leak, leave the premises immediately, and take others with you. Once you are safe distance away, call 1-800-75ConEd (1-800-752-6633). (Note: Customers in National Grid's gas service territory in Brooklyn, Staten Island, and parts of Queens, should call 1/718-643-4050).

Your cooperation, which will ensure the reliability and safety of your installation, is appreciated.
