
## Con Edison Average Monthly NYC Electric Residential Bills 600 kWh




## Con Edison Average Monthly Westchester Electric Residential Bills 600 kWh




## Con Edison Average Monthly NYC Electric Commercial Bill 12,600 kWh

### **Con Edison Average Electric Bill Calculation Notes**

Bill amounts are averages of twelve monthly bills for each year, based on the consumption level indicated on each chart. Actual customer consumption and demand will vary

Delivery Charges include: Customer Charge, Delivery (Energy and Demand) Charges, Monthly Adjustment Clause ("MAC"), MAC Adjustment, Billing and Payment Processing Charge, Delivery Revenue Surcharge, Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Adjustment, Dynamic Load Management Surcharge, applicable Metering Charges, VDER Cost Recovery, AMP Recovery, and EVMR Charge.

Commodity Charge includes: Market Supply Charge ("MSC"), MSC I Adjustment, Merchant Function Charge, MSC II Adjustment, and Clean Energy Standard Supply Surcharge.

Surcharges include: Systems Benefits Charge, Renewable Portfolio Standard Charge, Temporary State Assessment Surcharge, Clean Energy Standard Delivery Surcharge, Tax Surcredit, and Gross Receipts Tax.

Taxes and fees, including property taxes, federal and state income taxes, payroll and other taxes, and regulatory commission fees, comprise approximately 32% of the total bill based on the average monthly NYC residential bill at 280 kWh.
