## Success Story: Beekman Hill Cooperative

## Overview

The luxurious 13-story Beekman Hill Cooperative in Manhattan needed to upgrade its inefficient 60-year-old steam heating, cooling, and hot water system. Excited by the opportunity to lead in sustainability, residents partnered with Ventrop Engineering and **Con Edison's Clean Heat Program** to electrify the outdated system.

Electrifying Beekman Hill proved more complex than anticipated due to the existing system design, which serves chilled and hot water via 2-pipe distribution to fan coil units. Ventrop found this setup incompatible with standard electrification methods, making for costly and disruptive construction. Determined to find a solution, Ventrop and residents explored innovative technologies that could work with the existing infrastructure.

With **\$1 million in incentives** from **Con Edison's Clean Heat Program** and \$159,000 from NYSERDA's Low Carbon Pathway, they installed Colmac Water-to-Water heaters and Aremec Heat Pumps. These systems produce chilled and hot water compatible with the building's 2-pipe system, allowing Beekman Hill to successfully electrify its space cooling, heating, and hot water without a complete overhaul.

These upgrades helped achieve a **60% reduction in energy use** and a **76% decrease in greenhouse gas emissions**, compared to the prior steam system. Beekman Hill residents now enjoy lower energy bills, improved comfort, and set an example for other New York City buildings.
