For more than 21 years, Elsa Frias has proudly owned and operated Lorraine's Unisex, a hair salon named after her daughter. When she first opened in 2004, she transformed a long-vacant, rundown building in the Bronx into a thriving salon with eight residential units above it—helping to revitalize the community.

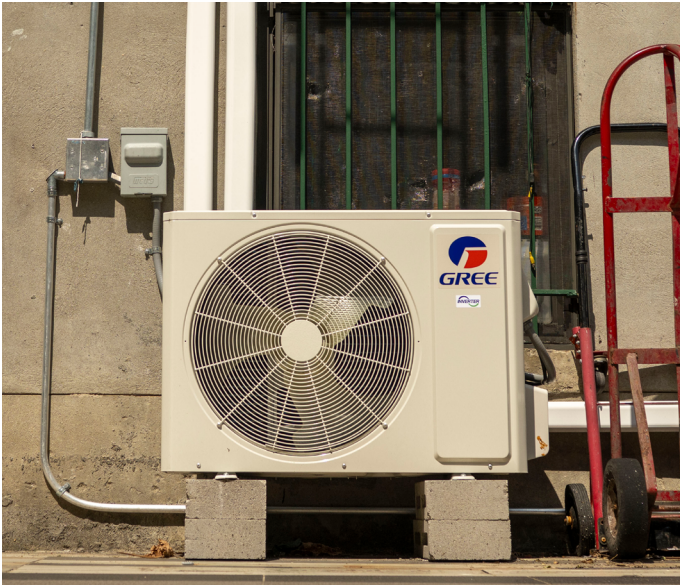
Elsa was looking for ways to lower winter heating costs and improve temperature control. With help from Con Edison's **Small Biz Program**, she **received \$10,000 in incentives** and worked with Dazong HVAC to install two air-source heat pumps at her store. The upgrades not only increased the store's energy efficiency, but they also improved the comfort of the store's workers and customers.

As comfort and efficiency are priorities for Elsa both at work and at home, she installed an air-source heat pump in her home using incentives from another Con Edison residential program.
