Overview

Founded in 1961, The Lorge School is a private nonprofit school in Manhattan that serves children with learning and emotional disabilities from disadvantaged backgrounds.

After multiple boiler breakdowns in the middle of winter interrupted the curriculum, the school recognized the urgent need to update its heating and lighting systems. Sustainability was also a priority, and the school was interested in upgrades that would help reduce its carbon footprint while saving energy and money in the long term.

Through Con Edison's Small Biz Energy Efficiency Program, they received incentives to install new lighting and heat pumps for heating and cooling, which allowed the school to be fully operational again.

With savings from the upgrades, the school can invest directly in programs for the students.
