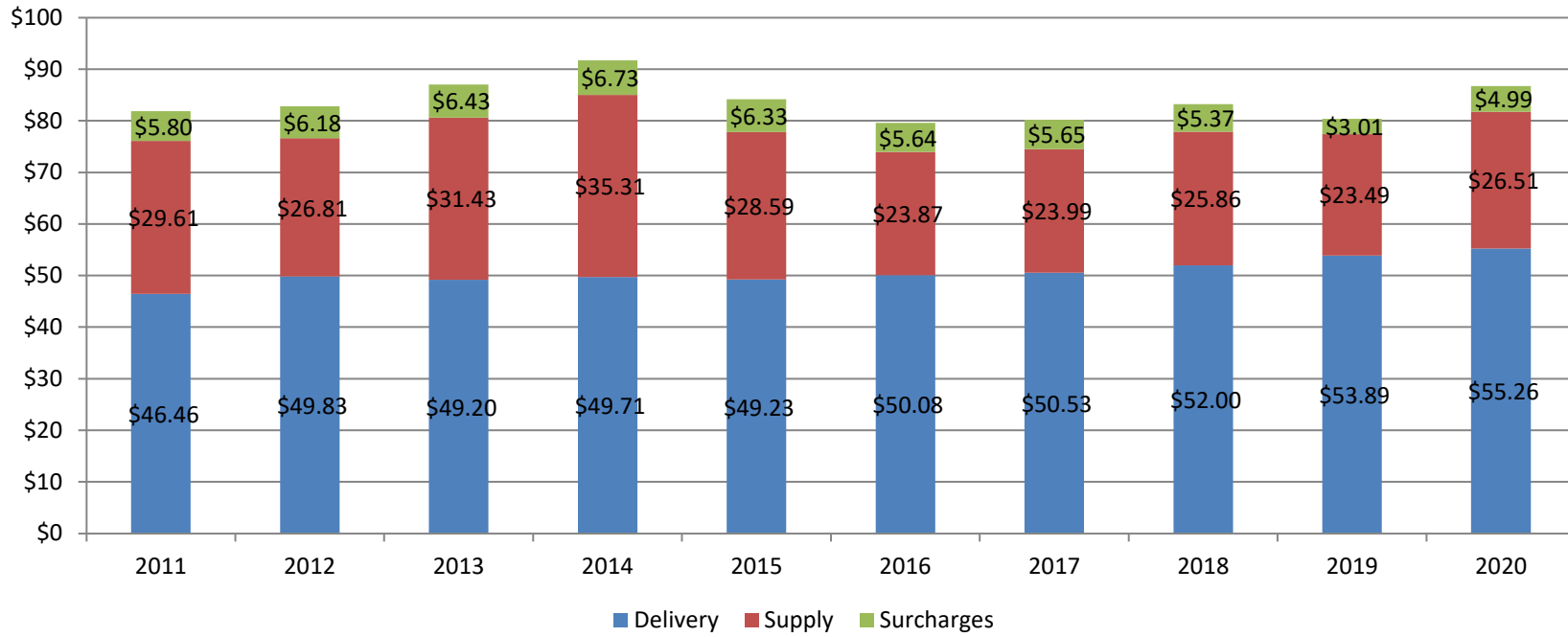
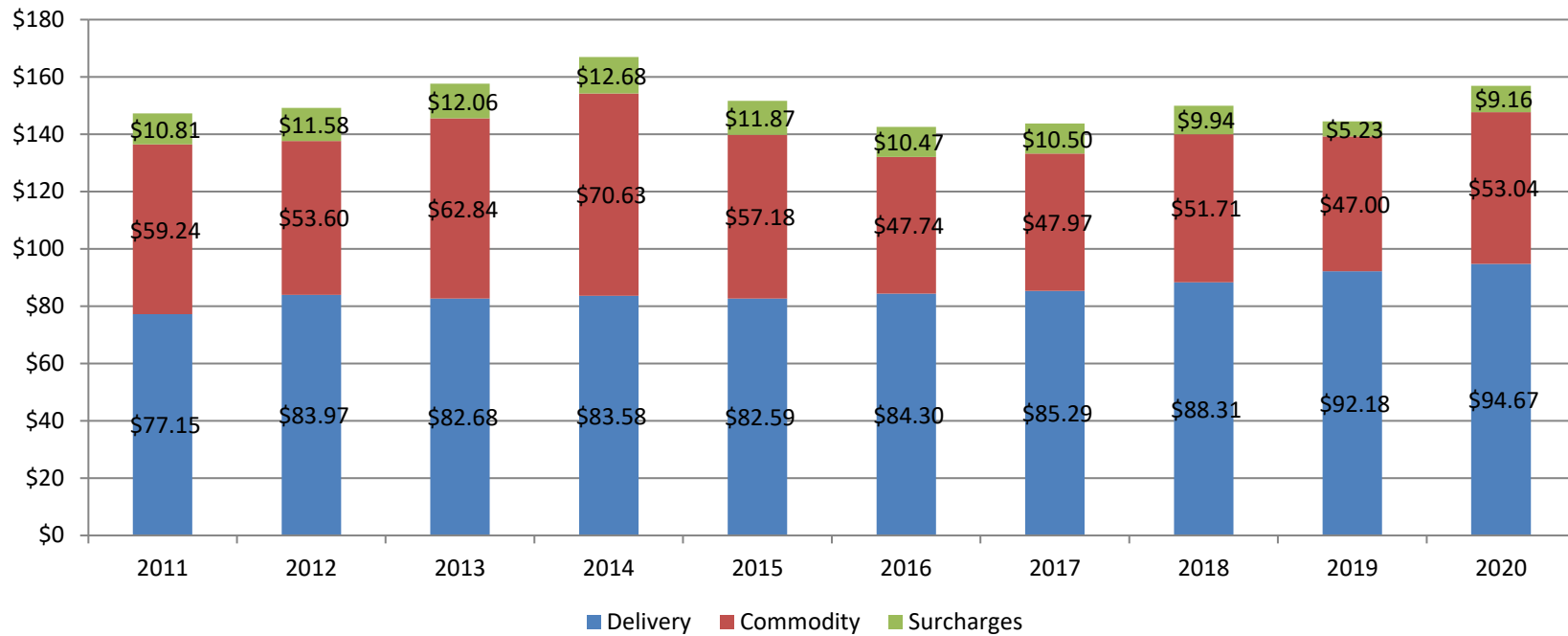


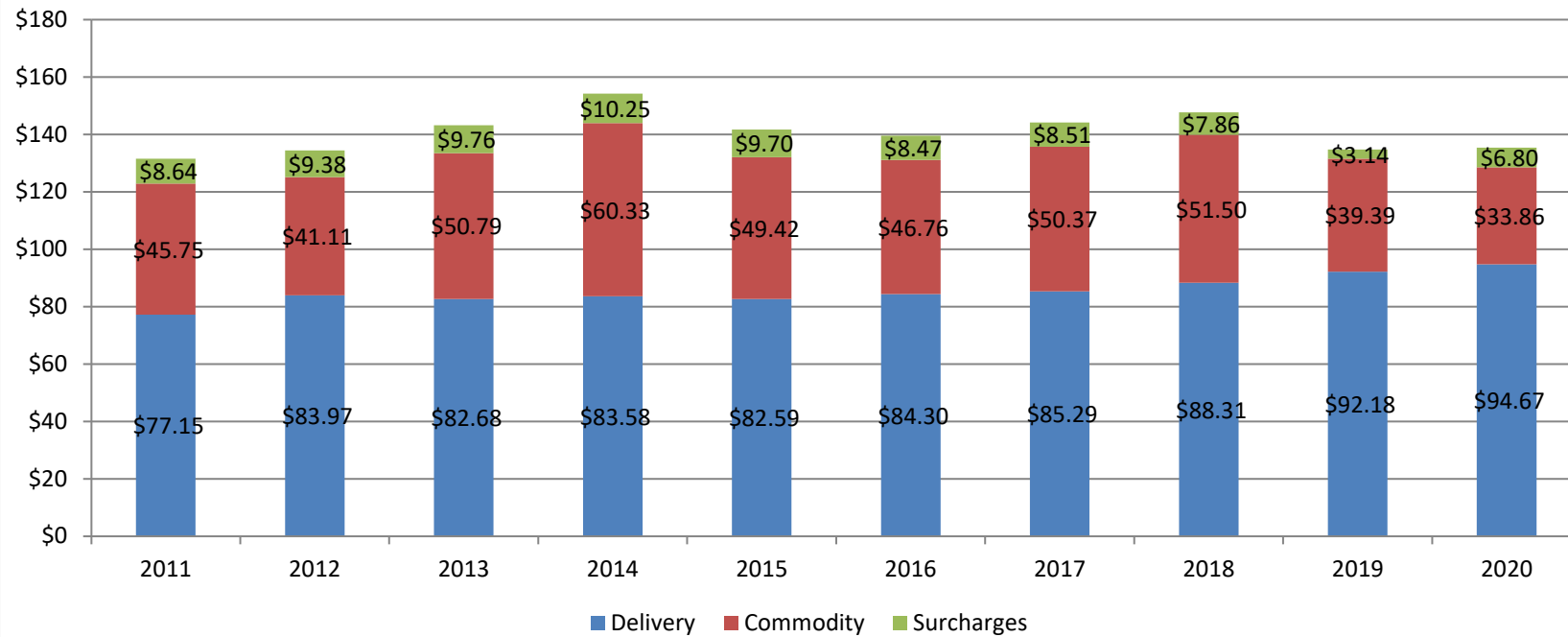
CECONY Average Monthly NYC Residential Bills 300 kWh



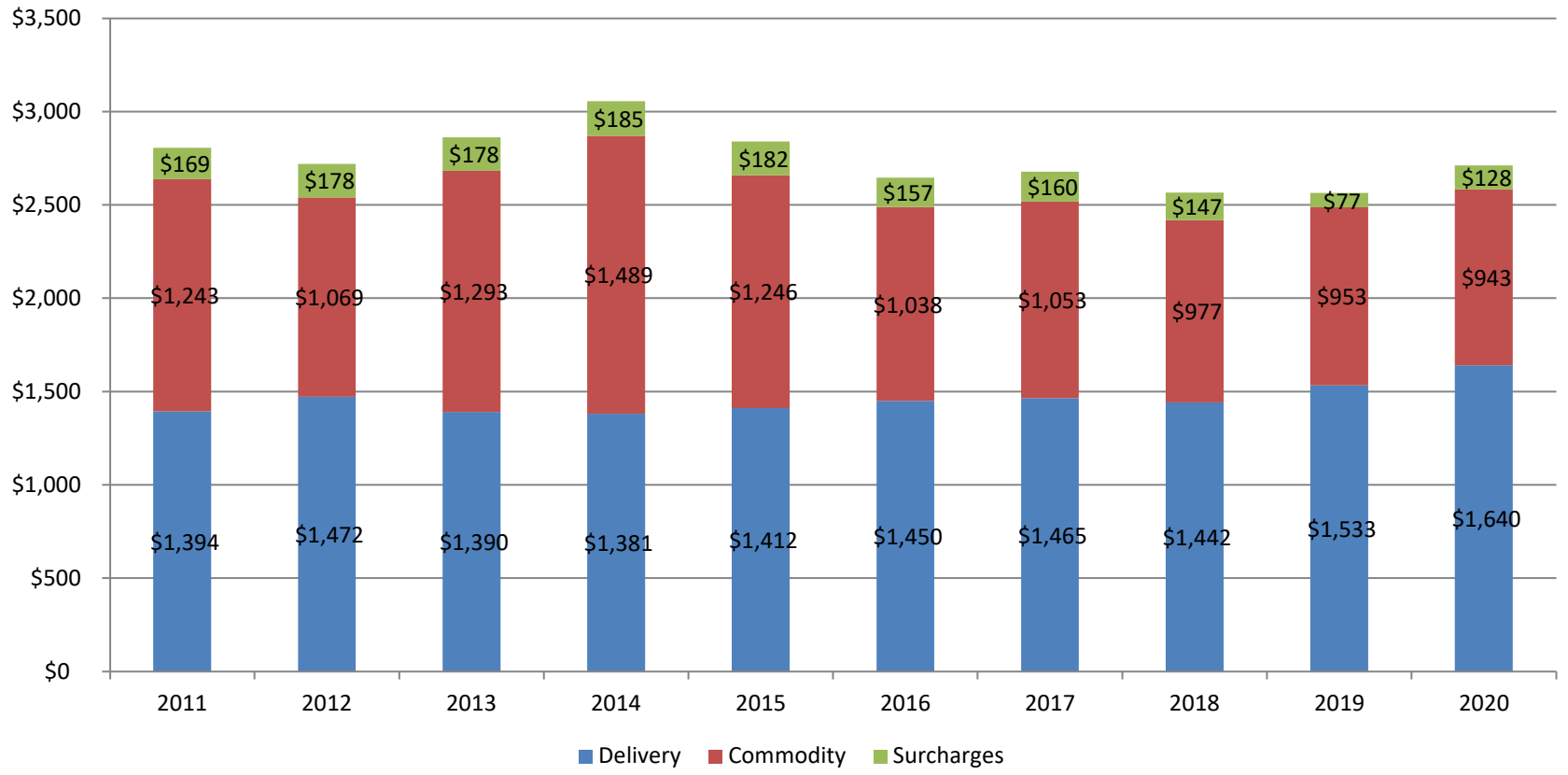
CECONY Average Monthly NYC Residential Bills 600 kWh



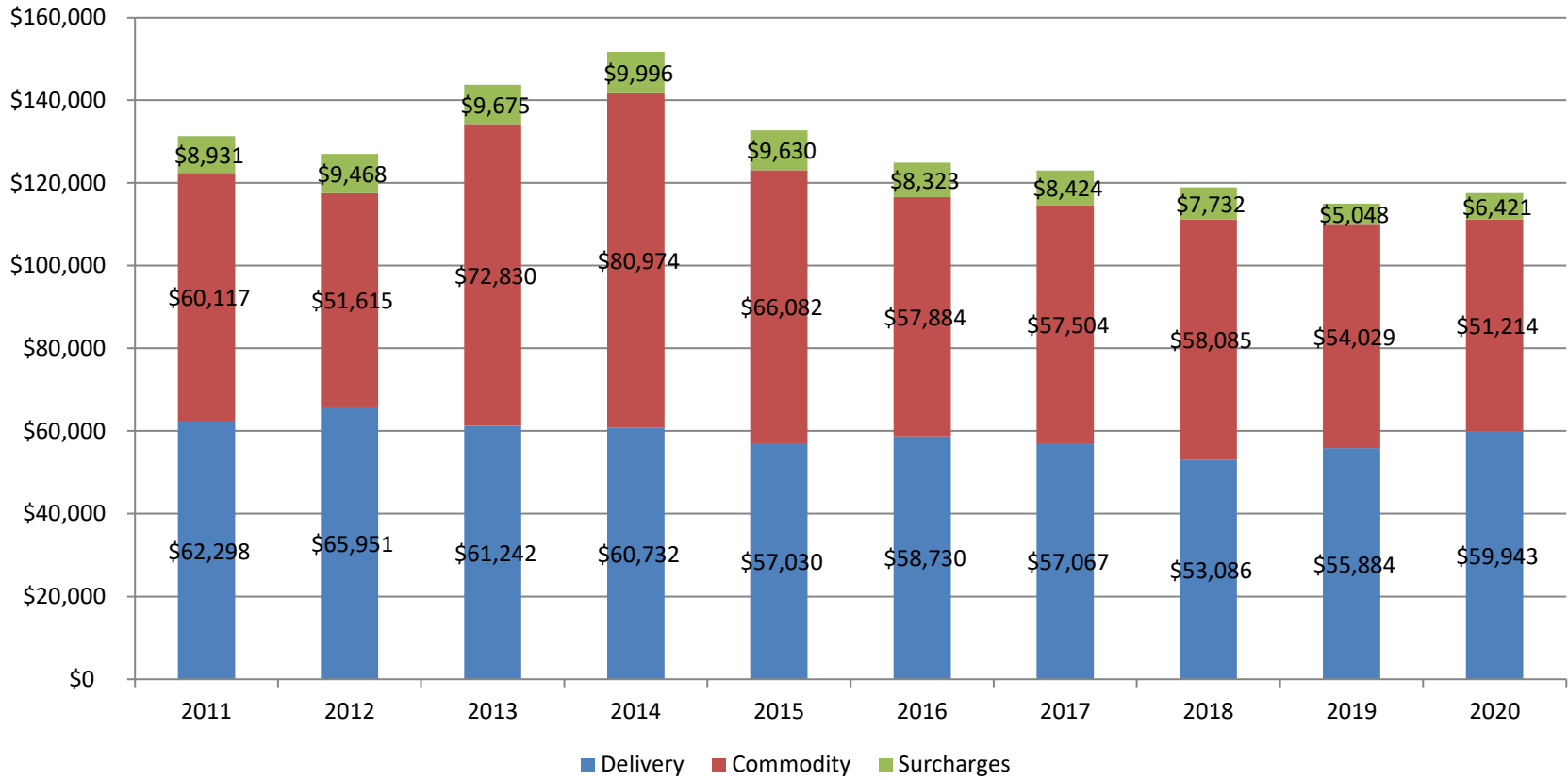
CECONY Average Monthly Westchester Residential Bills 600 kWh

CECONY Average Electric Bill Calculation Notes

Bill amounts are averages of twelve monthly bills for each year, based on the consumption level indicated on each chart. The customer consumption levels are determined by the New York State Department of Public Service. Actual customer consumption and demand will vary.

Delivery Charges include: Customer Charge, Delivery (Energy and Demand) Charges, Monthly Adjustment Clause ("MAC"), MAC Adjustment, Billing and Payment Processing Charge, Delivery Revenue Surcharge, Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Adjustment, Dynamic Load Management Surcharge, applicable Metering Charges, and VDER Cost Recovery

Commodity Charge includes: Market Supply Charge ("MSC"), MSC I Adjustment, Merchant Function Charge, MSC II Adjustment and Clean Energy Standard Supply Surcharge

Surcharges include: Systems Benefits Charge, Renewable Portfolio Standard Charge, Temporary State Assessment Surcharge, Clean Energy Standard Delivery Surcharge and Gross Receipts Tax, Tax Surcredit
