Reason for Filing

Pursuant to the Commission’s Order Approving Temporary Emergency Financial Relief for Electric Low-Income Bill Discount Program Customers, issued and effective June 11, 2020, in Case No. 20-M-0231 (the “Order”), the Company issued ESCCs for four monthly periods with the last credit issued to Customers with bills scheduled to be issued on October 14, 2020. The Company is issuing an updated Statement of ESCC to set it to zero effective October 15, 2020, since the ESCC has ended.
