RE: Case 15-E-0751, In the Matter of the Value of Distributed Energy Resources

Dear Secretary Burgess:

On September 23, 2019, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) filed with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) a draft proposal related to Standby Service and Buyback rates in compliance with the Commission’s Order on Standby and Buyback Service Rate Design and Establishing Optional Demand-based Rates, issued and effective May 16, 2019, in Case 15-E-0751 (the “Order”).

Since making the September 23, 2019 filing, the Company has discovered an error in the as-used daily demand rates shown on the draft tariff leaves included in that filing. Therefore, this filing includes draft tariff leaves, in clean format, that reflect the corrected as-used daily demand rates. This filing also includes rate design workpapers for the draft standby and buyback rates and workpapers supporting the Allocated Embedded Cost of Service (“ACOS”) study submitted on September 23, 2019.

The table below shows the workpaper files and a brief description for each of the files.
