Re: Retirement Benefit Changes

Dear Retiree:

Below is information regarding the 2017 Cost of Living Adjustment and how it will affect your pension benefits, as well as information on upcoming changes to the Retiree Health Program.

2017 Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA)

If you began receiving a pension benefit in December 2016 or earlier, the amount of your April 2017 pension check will increase by 1.6%. This increase is the cost-of-living adjustment that takes place every year that there is an increase in the Consumer Price Index. So, if your monthly pension has been \$1,000, it will increase to \$1,016.

Retiree Health Program - Preventive Medical Services Added

Effective April 1, 2017, if you and/or your spouse are enrolled in the Cigna plan offered by the company, whether or not you use Medicare, you and/or your spouse are eligible for a free, comprehensive wellness exam. This exam can be done at Affiliated Physicians or by an in-network Cigna provider. To schedule an appointment with Affiliated Physicians, please call 1-212-935-8725. Other preventive medical services will also be covered such as immunizations and screening for diabetes. If you are Medicare eligible, coverage for preventive medical services will be coordinated with Medicare.
